Foundations of Faith

As teachers and leaders of children, it is important for all of us to be in agreement about what we believe at Stuart Heights Baptist Church. Please read a brief summary of what we believe and sign below if you agree to uphold these teachings.

- The Scriptures - The Bible was written by man but inspired by God. It is the believer's only infallible rule of faith and practice (Ps. 119: 105; II Tim. 3:16-17.)
- The Godhead - We believe in one God, self-existent in three persons of equal nature: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. (Deut. 6:4; Matt. 28:19; II Cor. 13:14.)
- The Person and Work of Jesus Christ - He was born of a virgin and lived a sinless life. (Matt. 1:18-25; Heb. 4:15.) By His sacrificial death on a cross, Jesus made atonement for the sins of the world. (Isa. 53:4-6; II Cor. 5:14-15; I John 2:2.) We believe in Jesus' bodily resurrection three days after His death.
- Man - We believe that by virtue of Adam's sin, all men are sinners, alienated from God, and unable to remedy this on their own. (Rom. 3:23; 5:12; Eph. 2:1-3, 12.)
- Salvation - We believe that our salvation has been accomplished solely by Jesus Christ's death on the cross (Rom. 5:8-10; I Pet. 2:24.) Salvation is God's free gift of eternal life provided by His grace and received by man through repentance and personal faith in the Lord Jesus Christ. (John 3:16; Eph. 2:3-10.) Once saved, believers are kept safe and secure in Christ forever. (Jn. 10:27-30; Rom. 8:28-30.)
- The Believer's Walk -We believe that Christians are exhorted to try to live their lives controlled by the Holy Spirit and not to yield to sin. (Gal. 5: 16-26.)
